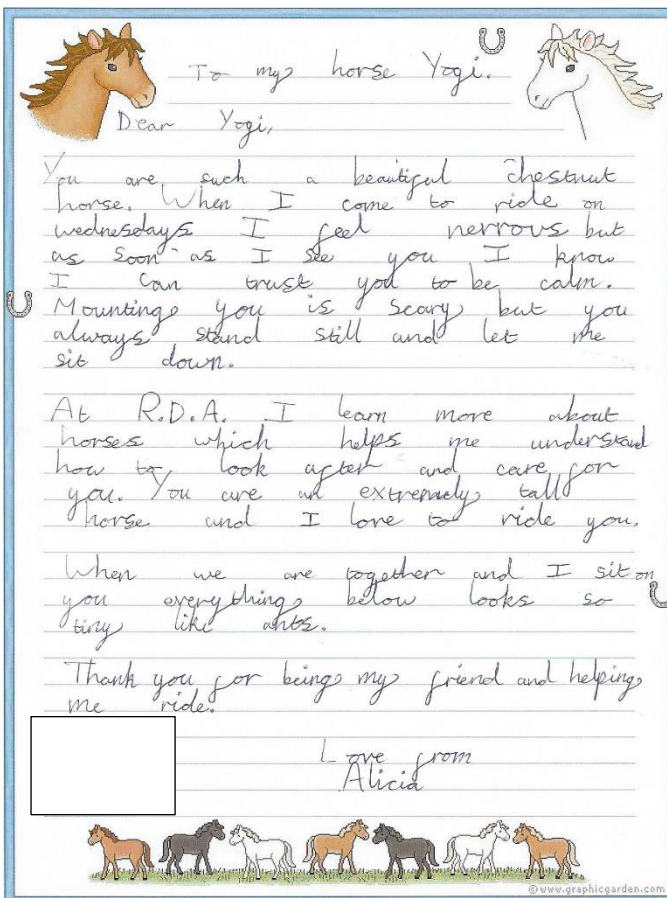

SBRDA Fundraising Committee

At the end of November 2019 I was lucky enough to have the opportunity to represent South Bucks RDA at a reception following the National RDA AGM in London, the day started rather strangely when I met and spoke to Ann Widdecombe on Paddington station, I then had my first experience of an Uber and later in the day at the reception had the pleasure of meeting HRH Princess Anne.

During the reception I also met several other people who all have some sort of voluntary role in RDA Groups around the UK, I've been taking either one or both of my sons to South Bucks for the past 11 years, I'm now going into my third year as a trustee and learning more all the time about RDA, talking to these volunteers from other groups I found that we at SBRDA are really fortunate to have the facilities we have at Fulmer, I spoke to two ladies who run a group quite close to ours but have to borrow everything and can only offer rides 2 mornings a week, not only that but another RDA group also use the same yard and ride on 2 other mornings, someone else I spoke to from a group a bit further away have to use borrowed ponies, have some of their own equipment and have to fundraise like mad to survive, then there's a group in north Bucks that have facilities but no indoor arena so if it's too cold or wet they have to cancel rides.

We are so lucky to have the facilities we have at Mill House Farm and to be honest most of us take it for granted that no matter what rides will take place more or less every day of every week of the year.

South Bucks RDA have staff, volunteers, our own horses and ponies, buildings, fields, woods and vehicles, as riders or parents we can arrive, park and have a lesson or ride in comfortable surroundings, head off home and know it will all be there ready for next time, when we stand or sit on the gallery and watch we see all the hard work going on in front of us and believe me there's a lot of hard work behind the scenes too.

We always need more volunteers to help lead a pony and rider or to side help, so if your able it's really rewarding and good fun to be part of the team, our instructors are able to give Green Card training for the role and of course it's subject to a DBS check but that's quite painless.



We also need to constantly raise funds, we already have 8 events we hope to organise or attend during 2020 so please support us in these, details will be emailed out by Gina and will also be posted on the green notice board on the gallery by the fire exit, please help us to keep SBRDA as the wonderful place it is, we wouldn't ever want to struggle as some of our neighbouring groups do.

If you can help as a volunteer or help us with fundraising then please contact Di, Caro, Gina or myself at the yard.
