Based in Fulmer, Buckinghamshire, South Bucks RDA is a Charity providing people with disabilities with the opportunity to ride and have equine interaction to benefit their health and well-being.

Our specially chosen and trained horses and ponies are looked after by our dedicated team of staff and volunteers, and they provide equine related experiences for approximately 100 people each week, which includes riders, visitors with dementia, Alzheimer's, and those who want to come and be with our horses and ponies.

Sponsors are needed to help to provide feed, bedding, shoeing and veterinary care for each of our twelve horses and ponies. Each pony costs around £3500 a year to keep and each horse over £5000 and that is without veterinary fees. Shoeing alone costs around £500 per animal annually. We receive no local authority or Government funding.

Our horses and ponies have supported: four Paralympics World and European Gold Medallists during their formative years of training; our riders to compete at Regional and National competitions; and riding for pleasure and therapy. They also support the well-being of individuals of all ages with dementia, Alzheimer's, anxiety, and stress.

The Direct Debit Guarantee

If you request Charities Aid Foundation to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Charities Aid Foundation or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Charities Aid Foundation asks you to
